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K-266 in Republic County gets Mill & Overlay

Beginning Wednesday, July 11, 2012, K-266 will be under construction. Plans call for the entire route (beginning at the K-266/US-36 intersection then north 7.5 miles to the Pawnee Indian Museum Historical Site) will be milled to a depth of ½ inch followed by a ¾ inch asphalt overlay.

Traffic will be carried through construction via pilot car and flaggers. Work will be conducted during daylight hours only. Drivers can expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Plans call for the project to be completed on or about July 27th weather permitting.

Hall Brothers Inc of Marysville, KS is the prime contractor. Project cost is \$477,688.47.
