# **KDOT** to host regional Long Range Transportation Plan meetings

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will host a series of eight regional meetings across the state to review and receive comments on the recommendations in the Kansas Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP).

The LRTP, which is still under development, will be a broad policy document that will guide the state's transportation decision-making into the future. KDOT has worked for nearly a year with more than 150 stakeholders in an extensive and collaborative dialogue process to develop the LRTP. It is important to note that the LRTP does not set out a new transportation funding program for Kansas.

At these meetings KDOT will be seeking comments from attendees to ensure that the recommendations are responsive to the transportation needs of Kansas residents. The regional meetings will be held:
