Survey to begin on US-77 Highway

Starting around February 1, and continuing for five months, the Kansas Department of Transportation will have a field survey team surveying a 9.5 mile section of US-77, from the south city limits of Winfield continuing south to 1.86 miles north of the north junction of US-77/US-166 in Cowley County. The purpose of the survey is to gather information necessary to create detailed designs for future construction projects.
