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Tuttle Creek bridge project closure to start Feb 21

Work will soon begin on the Tuttle Creek spillway bridge, which will close the bridge Feb. 21 and require detours to cross Tuttle Creek Reservoir.

The closure will be part of an Army Corps of Engineers project to replace the bridge deck on the spillway bridge on K-13 in Pottawatomie County.

Work is set to begin Feb. 21 and is planned until mid-November, 2018.


Permanent Closures

Wednesday, Feb. 21 to a tentative date of mid-Nov. 2018

- K-13 eastbound and westbound over the spillway will be closed for bridge repair.

Detours:

- The main detour around the spillway from the north or east via K-16 and K-13 will be K-16 westbound to US-77 southbound and US-24 eastbound.
- The main detour route around the spillway from the south via US 24 will be to travel west on US 24 to US-77 northbound to K-16 eastbound and K-13 southbound
- K-13 across Tuttle Creek Lake is not closed, access to Tuttle Creek State Park and businesses will remain accessible from the west.
 - Temporary signs will be added on K-13, US-77, US-24 and at junctions on K-16.
