Anschutz celebrates 30 years of service at KDOT

Michelle Anschutz, Field Engineering Administrator (FEA) for District One's Topeka Metro office, has achieved a career milestone and is celebrating 30 years of valued service to the State of Kansas.

Anschutz followed in her family's career path at the Kansas Department of Transportation. She started as an Inspector of Materials in Research in 1988. After receiving a civil engineering degree from the University of Kansas in 1991, she became the Project Engineer at the Horton Construction Office and was promoted to Construction Engineer two years later. In 2015, she was selected to her current position.

As FEA, Anschutz directs engineering and inspection staff on state and federal highway construction projects in Topeka, Lawrence, Emporia and the surrounding areas. She also serves as the Title VI Coordinator for northeast Kansas.

Anschutz was a speaker at the National American Concrete Paving Association Conference in 2017, has received several awards for partnering efforts and received a certificate from the Office of Judicial Administration of the Kansas Supreme Court for mediation.
