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US-36 Pavement Repair Project Begins in Brown & Doniphan Counties

On **Monday, October 29**, a concrete pavement repair project began on a 14.6-mile portion of US-36 from just west of Ash Point Road in Brown County to east of East Locust Street in Troy (Doniphan County). Project work includes full and partial depth patching of the existing concrete pavement. Work will take place during daylight hours, Monday through Friday, with some occasional Saturday work. The work will be coordinated so that all lanes will be opened to traffic by one-half before sunset.

Beginning on **Monday, October 29**, eastbound and westbound US-36 traffic will be reduced to one lane for both directions along with intermittent closures of adjacent cross roads during the project work hours for pavement repair work. Traffic will be directed through the project work zone via a pilot car and flagger operation. Drivers should expect delays of up to 15 minutes maximum and are encouraged to use alternate routes, if possible

Kansas Heavy Construction, LLC (Shawnee, KS) is the primary contractor on this pavement repair project with a total contract cost of \$646,634. **Overall project work is scheduled to be completed in late December 2012, weather permitting.**
