Additional lane closures, Jefferson and Leavenworth counties

Additional lane closures are scheduled in Jefferson and Leavenworth counties, Friday, July 24, weather permitting. Traffic on these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Jefferson County –

For pavement marking, the closures include:

- Single lane closure on U.S. 59, from Hickory Point Road moving south to the Oskaloosa southern city limits. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Friday, July 24. Traffic control will include a pilot car operation.

Leavenworth County –

For tree removal, the closures include:

- Single lane closure eastbound U.S. 24/40 in Tonganoxie from Washington Street to Eighth Street, Friday, July 24, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Traffic control will include a flagging operation.
