**Additional pothole patching in Johnson and Wyandotte  
counties this week**

The Kansas Department of Transportation will continue pothole patching in Johnson and Wyandotte counties this week, weather permitting.

**Johnson County -**

I-435 northbound and southbound will have various mobile lane closures from the Kansas River to K-10 for pothole patching.

I-435 eastbound and westbound will have various mobile lane closures from Metcalf Avenue to State Line Road.

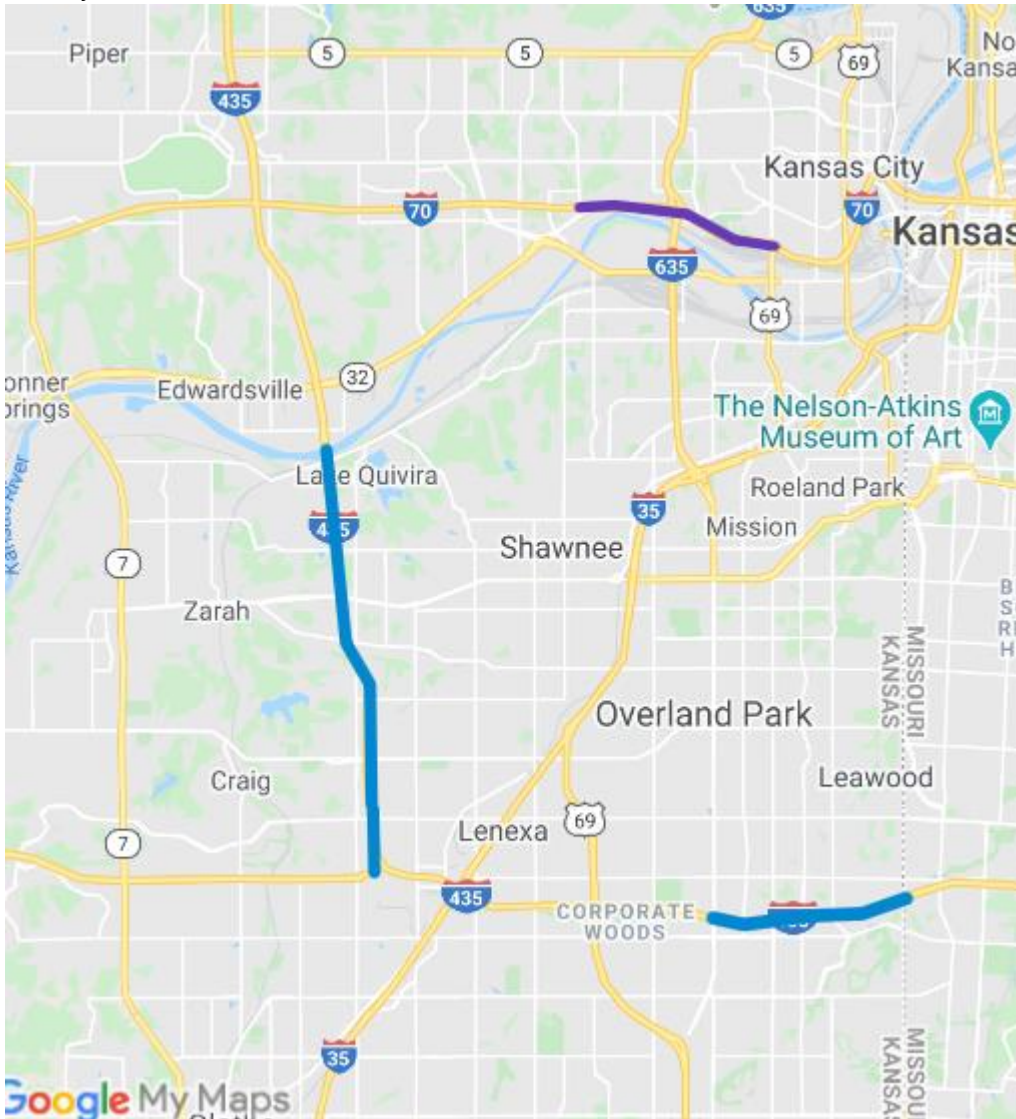
Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and is expected to be completed Fri. March 6.

**Wyandotte County –**

Night work on I-70 between 57<sup>th</sup> Street and 18<sup>th</sup> Street will continue to Mar. 6. Work will occur from 6 p.m. to 5 a.m. and includes ramps at I-635/I-70 and 38<sup>th</sup> Street/I-70.

Traffic will be controlled by mobile lane closures using trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards
