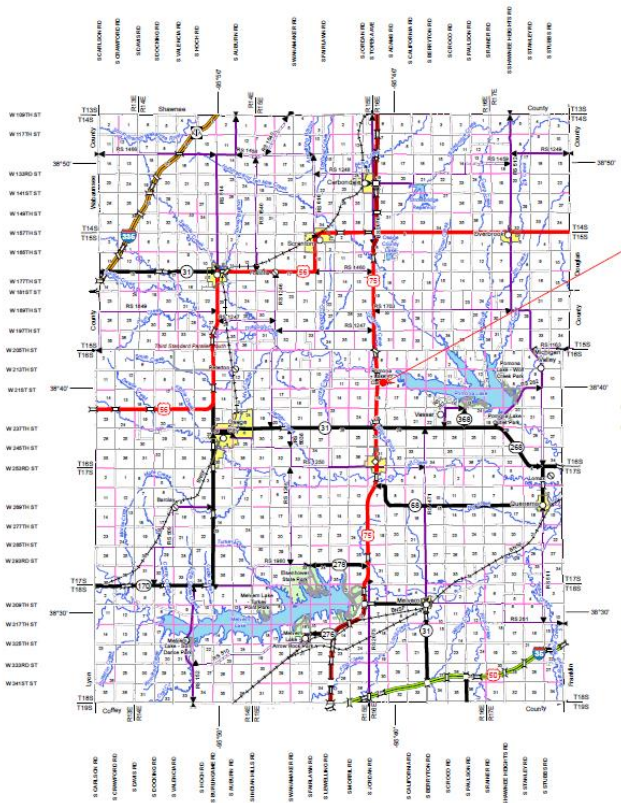
Field survey, U.S. 75 in Osage County begins next week

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to conduct a field survey on U.S. 75 in Osage County to begin, Monday, March 23, weather permitting.

The field survey will gather information that is necessary for the design of two proposed bridge replacement projects, two and four miles north of the Junction of U.S. 75/K-31. Survey is expected to last six weeks.

Traffic is not expected to be impacted. Survey crews may use traffic cones and caution signage to make drivers aware of survey crew personnel.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.

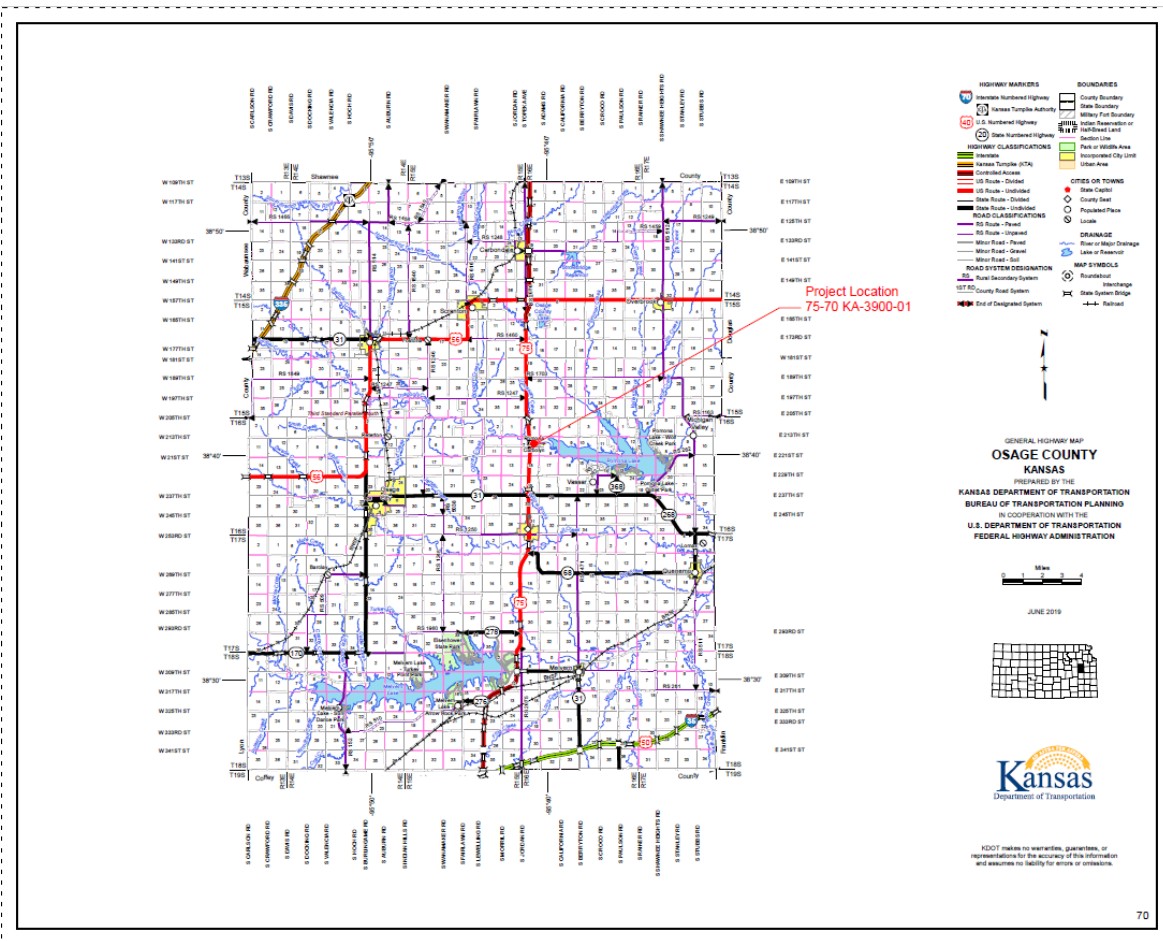
GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP
