Pedestrian and bike path project in Eudora to begin August 17

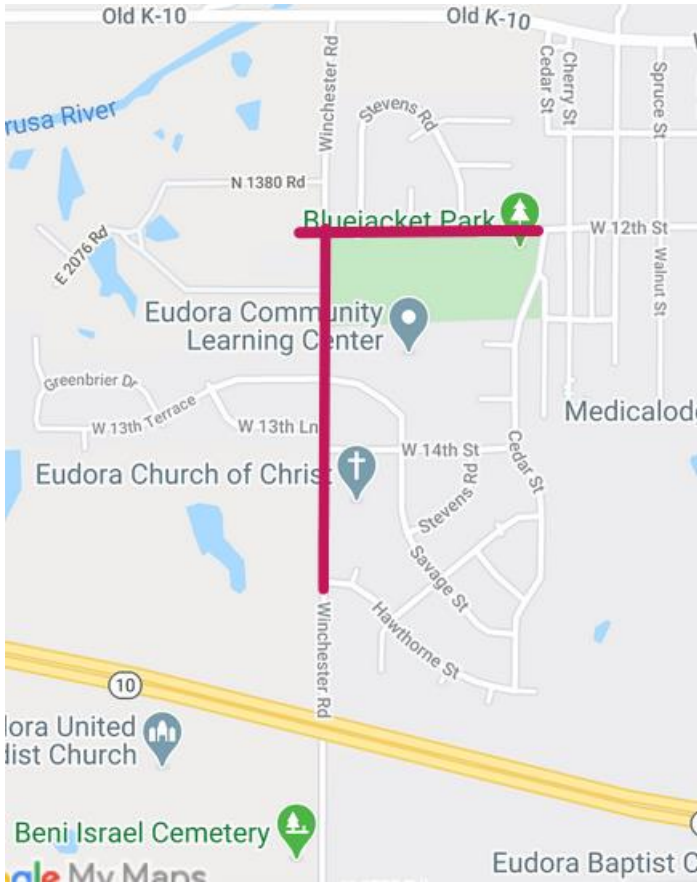
A pedestrian and bike path project in Eudora to begin Monday, August 17, weather permitting. The project will include Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps at Winchester Road from west of 12th Street to Hawthorn Street and west of 12th Street from Winchester Road east to the Bluejacket Park.

Work will occur from one half hour after sunrise to one half hour before sunset and is expected to be complete by the end of October.

Pedestrian traffic will encounter sidewalk closures for the duration of the project.

Freeman Concrete Construction, LLC of Shawnee is the contractor on the \$320,000 project.
