Pipe replacement on K-20 in Doniphan County Monday

A pipe replacement project on K-20 in Doniphan County to occur, Monday, May 18, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. This is expected to be a one-day project, weather permitting.

Cross road pipes will be replaced at two locations. The first pipe to be replaced is located one-half mile east of Ash Point Road at mile marker 23 and the second pipe to be replaced is located at the south limits of Denton at mile marker 29.

Traffic will be controlled using signage and traffic cones. There will not be any signed detour, travelers should expect delays and are advised to find alternate routes.
