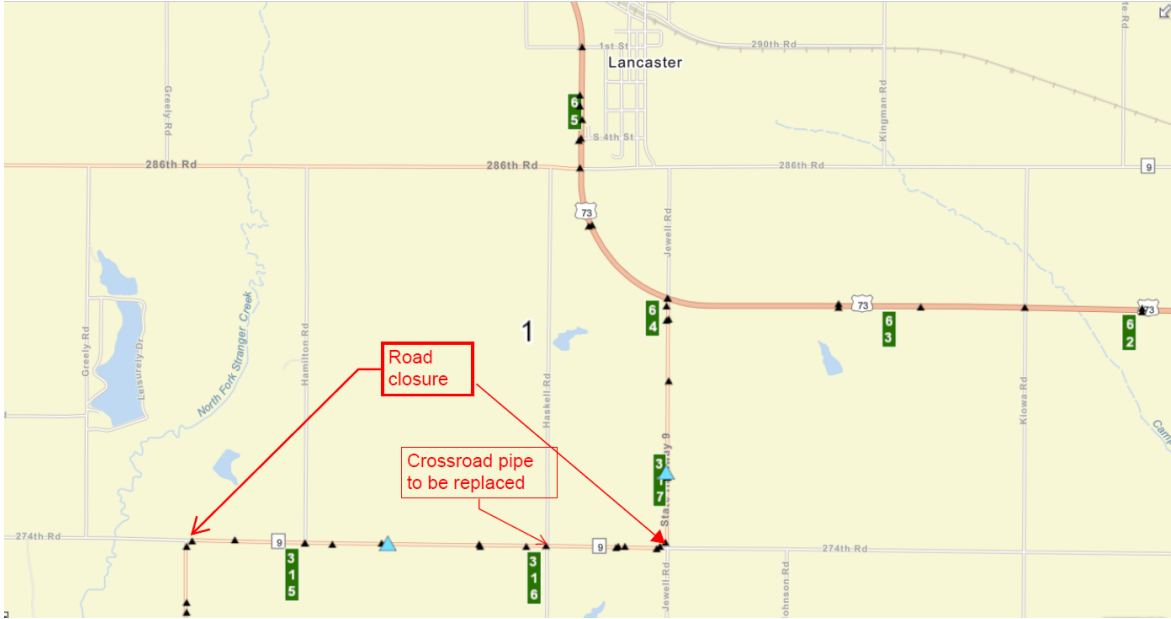
Pipe replacement on K-9 in Atchison County Thursday

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be replacing a crossroad pipe at K-9 and Haskell Road, in Atchison County, Thursday, June 25.

K-9 will be closed from approximately mile marker 314 to mile marker 316, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting. Drivers should expect delays and find an alternate route.

Traffic will be controlled using a road closure, signage and traffic cones.
