Pothole patching in Johnson County, bridge rail maintenance in Wyandotte County Feb. 28

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be performing pothole patching in Johnson County and bridge rail maintenance in Wyandotte County, Feb. 28, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

Johnson County –

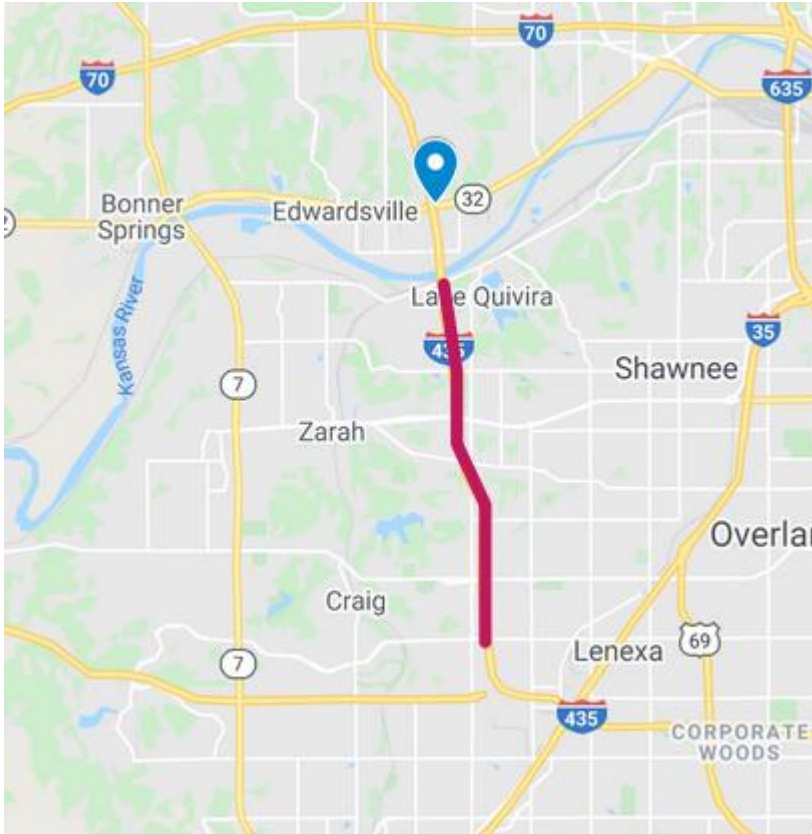
I-435 northbound and southbound will have various mobile lane closures from the Kansas River to 95th St. for pothole patching. Traffic will be controlled by mobile lane closures using trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards.

Wyandotte County –

Bridge rail maintenance will occur at northbound I-435/K-32 from 9 am to 3 pm, weather permitting. Left lane will be closed. Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and arrow board signs.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction
