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## **Resurfacing work to begin in Riley County Aug. 14**

Two connected projects will begin on U.S. 24 and U.S. 77 in Riley County on Friday, Aug. 14. The work is expected to be completed late September, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Crews will be resurfacing U.S. 77 beginning at mile marker 194 and U.S. 24 beginning near Randolph at mile marker 194 and extending south to U.S. 24 and continuing south on U.S. 24 to mile marker 311, weather permitting. Motorist will be directed through the construction area by flaggers and a pilot car. Drivers should expect delays of up to 15 minutes and plan accordingly.

Shilling Construction Co. of Manhattan is the prime contractor on the projects totaling \$2.3 million.
