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Survey for proposed replacement of Doniphan County bridge

A field survey is expected to begin Monday, Nov. 16 for the proposed replacement of Bridge #016 over Mill Creek in Doniphan County.

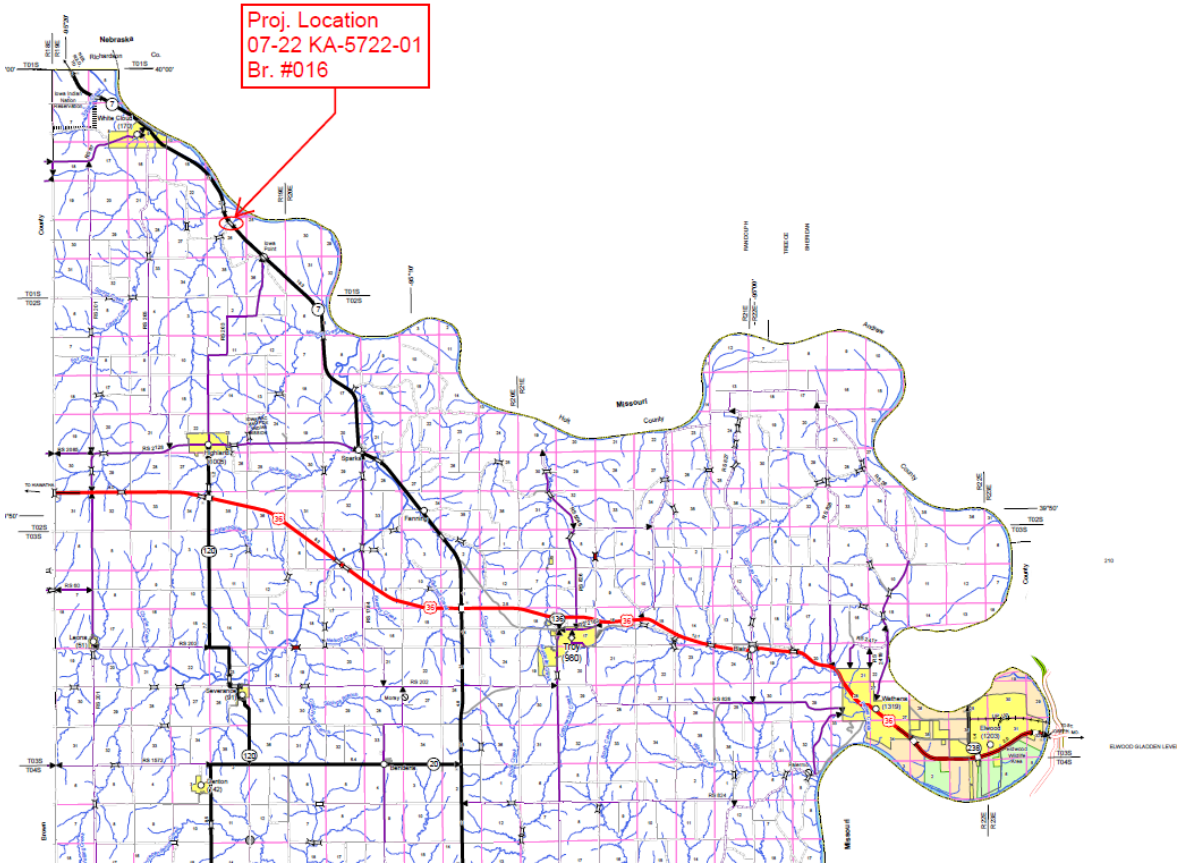
The proposed replacement is 12.45 miles northwest of the west U.S. 36/K-7 junction.

The survey is to gather information that is necessary for the detailed design of the bridge and expected completion is Feb. 1, 2021.

Johnny Yackle, P.S., Field Survey Project Manager, HDR, will be in charge of this survey for the Kansas Department of Transportation.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
