Traffic update, culvert replacement on K-99 in Wabaunsee County

The culvert replacement project on K-99, at approximately mile marker 154, in Wabaunsee County, is moving into the second phase. The temporary road is complete and two-lane traffic will be detoured on to it starting next week. Work will occur during daylight hours and is expected to be completed in mid-July, weather permitting.

There will a 25 miles per hour speed limit and traffic will be controlled using, speed limit signs, traffic cones and barricades.
