Culvert replacement on K-116 in Atchison County begins today


According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, a box culvert replacement project on K11 will begin March 31. The project is located about one-third of a mile west of the K-116/U.S. 59 junction on K-116.

Work will occur during daylight hours, Monday to Friday, Saturdays as needed, and expected completion is the end of July, weather permitting.

K-116 will be closed and a signed detour will route traffic south to the U.S. 159/U.S. 59 junction. (see map below) Traffic will be controlled using signage and traffic cones.

Pfefferkorn & Drury Construction Co. of Olathe is the contractor on the \$756,000 project.
