## Survey for proposed bridge replacement near K-116 in Atchison County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) to begin a field survey, Monday, Jan. 18, for proposed bridge replacements near K-116 in Atchison County.


The proposed bridge replacements are located three miles northeast of K-116 over Stranger Creek and about six miles northeast of K-116 over 262<sup>nd</sup> Road.

The survey is to gather information that is necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvement and is estimated to be completed by March 12, 2021.

Jed Baughman, P.S., Field Survey Project Manager, RIC, will be in charge of this survey for KDOT.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
