
K-4 overlay work next week in Shawnee and Jefferson counties

Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) maintenance crews will overlay various sideroads and business entrances along K-4 next week between mile markers 336 and 346 in Shawnee and Jefferson counties. Work will occur Monday, July 26, through Friday, July 30, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

KDOT crews will determine which locations require overlay and reduce traffic on K-4 to one lane around the active work area. Flaggers will direct northbound and southbound traffic through the work zone, which will be marked with signage and traffic cones.

Residential driveways will not be affected. Sideroads and business entrances will be accessible while crews work, however, closures of 30 minutes or less are possible.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
