

K-4 closure in Wabaunsee County on Aug. 4

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will close approximately 5 miles of K-4 in Wabaunsee County on Wednesday, Aug. 4, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., weather permitting.

K-4 will be closed between Illinois Creek Road and Caulk Road, approximately 6 miles east of Alta Vista, while maintenance crews replace a pipe under the roadway. There will be no detours provided, and drivers will need to find alternate routes.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
