U.S. 24 milling work in Jefferson County on Wednesday

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), milling work will occur on U.S. 24 at mile marker 384 in Jefferson County on Wednesday, June 30. Maintenance crews will work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

Flaggers will direct eastbound and westbound traffic through the work area. The work zone will be marked with signage and traffic cones.
