

K-18 lane reduction scheduled this week

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will complete milling work on K-18 in Riley and Wabaunsee counties this week from just east of Zeendale to the K-18/K-99 junction. Work will occur on Tuesday, Aug. 2, through Thursday, Aug. 4, from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., weather permitting.

Traffic will be restricted to one lane in the work zone and will be directed by a pilot car, flaggers, signs and cones. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
