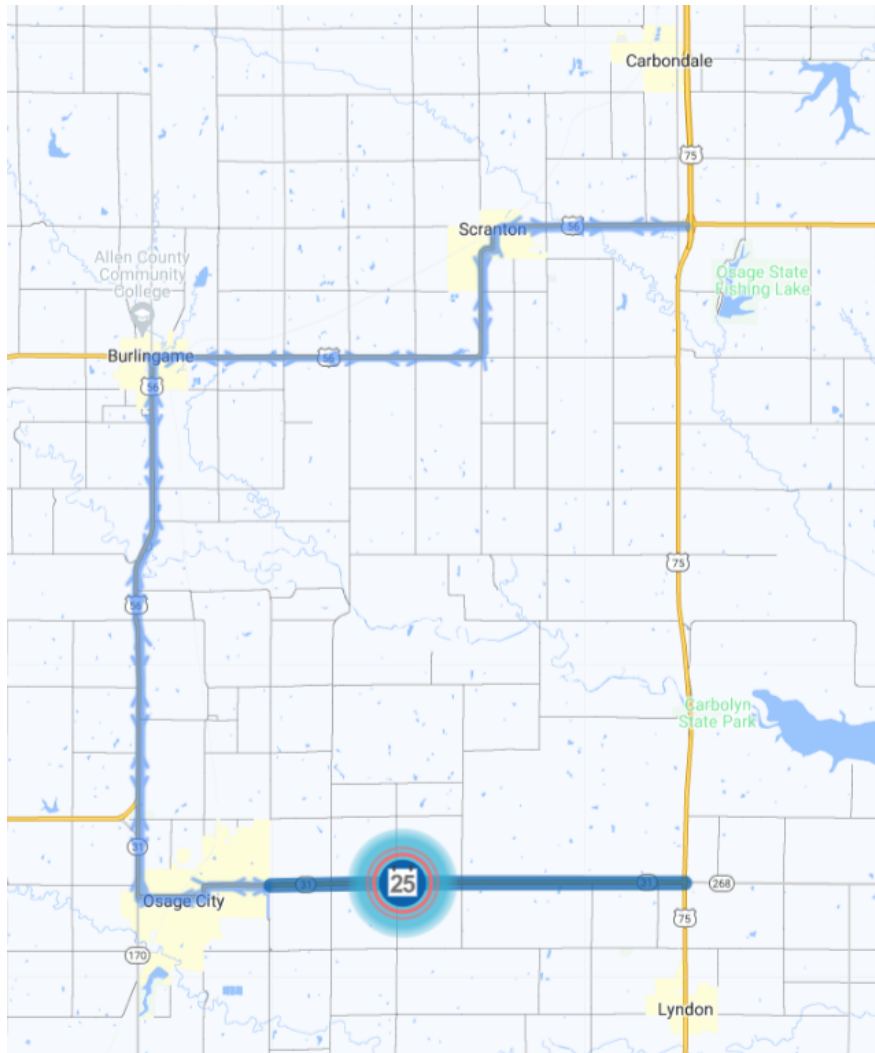
## **K-31 in Osage County to close July 25**

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to close a portion of K-31 in Osage County on Monday, July 25, weather permitting. The closure is just east of Osage City and will span approximately seven miles from South Indian Hills Road to U.S. 75.

The closure is part of the K-31 realignment project and is expected to be in place until early November.

Through traffic can follow the marked detour on U.S. 56 through Burlingame and Scranton. KDOT uses state highways for official detour routes for safety, weight and maintenance concerns.
