K-87 project underway in Marshall County


A patching and overlay project is underway on K-87 in Marshall County. The project covers approximately 9 miles, from the U.S. 36 junction to the city limits of Vliets.

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, traffic will be restricted to one lane in the work zone and will be directed by a pilot car, flaggers, signs, and cones. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes.

Patching work will occur Monday through Saturday during daylight hours and is expected to be complete by late October. The project will stop for the winter, and then overlay work will take place next spring.

Hall Brothers, Inc., of Marysville, is the contractor on the \$1.3 million project.
