Survey for U.S. 24 bridge replacement underway in Jefferson County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) began a field survey, Tuesday, April 19, in advance of a bridge replacement on U.S. 24 over Stone House Creek in Jefferson County.

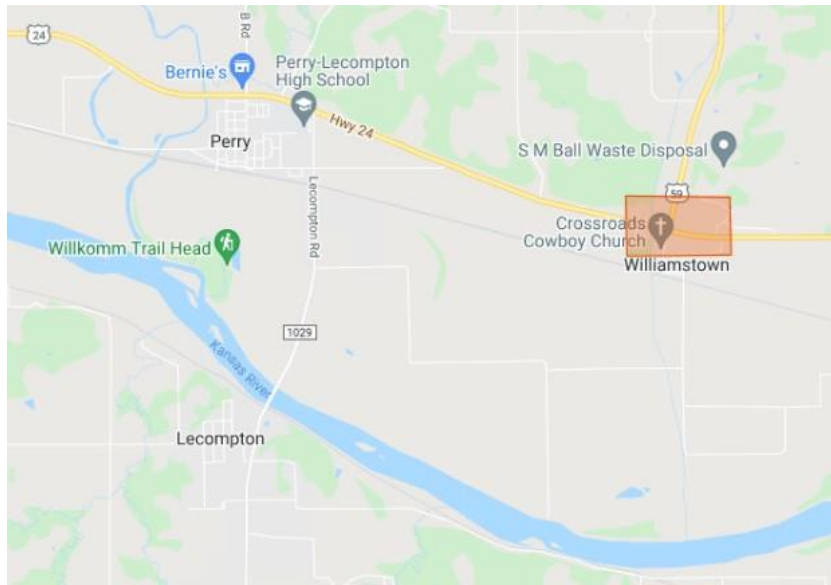
The stretch of roadway affected by the proposed bridge replacement is located 700 feet west of the U.S. 24/northbound U.S. 59 northbound intersection.

This survey is to gather information necessary for the detailed designed design of the proposed improvement and is estimated to be completed by May 26.

Joe Bowen, P.S., Survey Project Manager, is in charge of this survey for KDOT.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
