## Lyon County signing project begins Monday

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT), a signing project in Lyon County will begin on Monday, March 21, weather permitting. Contractors will replace signs located along U.S. 50, U.S. 56, K-99, K-78, K-130 and K-170.

Advanced signing and cones will mark the active work zone. Flaggers will direct traffic when a lane closure is necessary.

Komo Construction, LLC, of Lakeville, Minn., is the contractor on the \$335,000 project. Work is expected to be complete by June.
