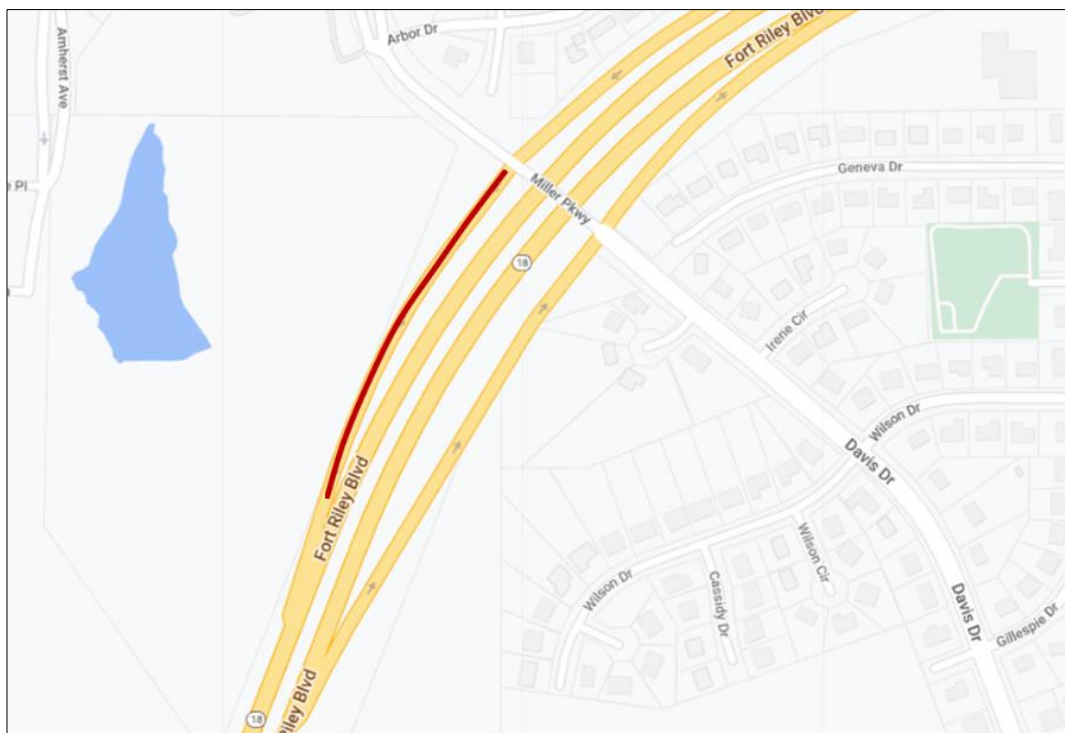

K-18 ramp closure scheduled in Manhattan

On Monday, Sept. 18, the Kansas Department of Transportation will close the ramp from Miller Parkway/Davis Drive to southbound K-18 in Manhattan for pavement repair work, weather permitting. The one-day closure will be in place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., or until work is complete.

The closure will be marked by barricades, signs and cones. No detours will be posted, and motorists will need to use alternate routes.
