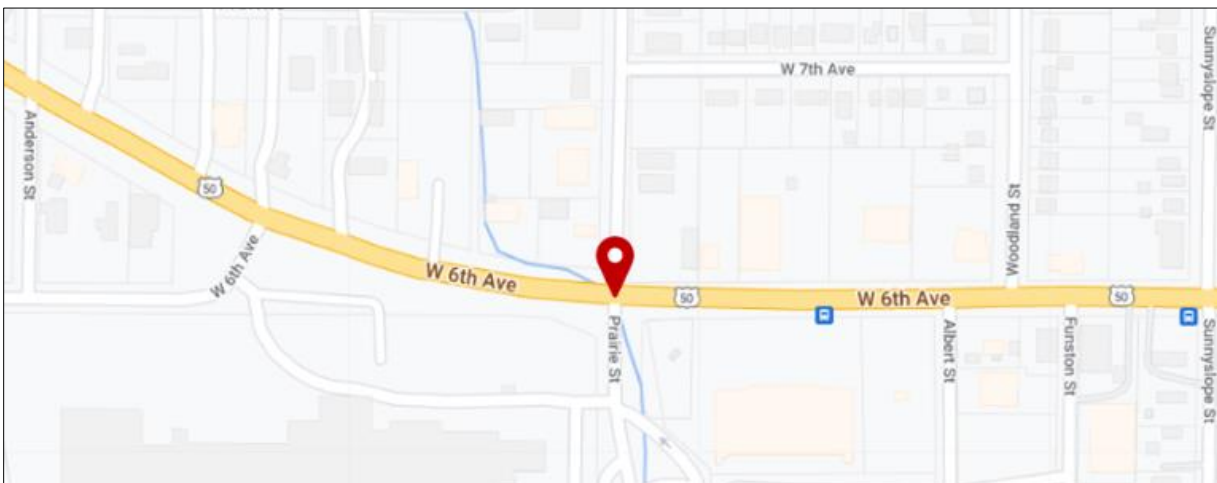

U.S. 50 intersection work planned in Emporia

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be working on the traffic signals at the intersection of U.S. 50/6th Avenue and Prairie Street in Emporia next week.

Intermittent lane closures are expected to occur at the intersection on Monday and Tuesday, Sept. 18 and 19, weather permitting. Motorists should plan for delays and add extra time to their commutes.
