## Westbound K-18 to 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit ramp and lane closure Monday in Riley County

The Kansas Department of Transportation to remove a sign structure on westbound K-18 at the 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit ramp on Monday. Work will occur at mile marker 183, near the Manhattan Regional Airport, and the right lane and exit ramp will be closed from 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Traffic will be stopped for approximately 10 - 15 minutes to move the sign and directed by using signs and traffic cones. Drivers should plan for delays of up to 15 minutes.
