EXPECT DELAYS! LANE CLOSURES: <u>Eastbound and westbound I-70 left</u> <u>lanes (right lanes open) from Valencia Road (Shawnee County) to K-30</u> (Wabaunsee County) will be CLOSED one day only for median crossover resurfacing work on Friday, June 7 between 7:00 a.m. and approximately 5:00 p.m. that same day, weather permitting.

Traffic will be directed through the project work zone via cones and signage. Advance message boards will alert drivers to the lane closures. Drivers should expect major delays during peak travel times.

NOTE: When the median crossover resurfacing work is completed that day, the <u>westbound I-70 left lane</u> will be **reopened** to all traffic, however, the <u>eastbound I-70 left lane</u> will **remain closed** as crews continue the resurfacing work on eastbound I-70. These daytime lane closures are part of the work on the eastbound I-70 resurfacing project that is scheduled for completion in late June 2013, weather permitting.
