- **FULL CLOSURE** of the <u>SW 25th Street Bridge over I-470:</u> (Alternate Route: Drivers can use 21st Street or Wanamaker Road)
- One lane closed in each direction on the <u>northbound and</u> southbound I-470 Bridges over Wanamaker Road

Advance message boards will alert drivers to the lane ramp closures. No marked detours will be provided. Drivers should **expect delays** and are advised to use alternate routes.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through the project work zone.
