For Wednesday, June 2, 2010 – Topeka/Shawnee County

I-70

Weather permitting, on **Tuesday, June 2 at 6:00 p.m.**, westbound I-70 will be reduced to one lane from 3.3 miles just west of Urish Road to Danbury Lane for continued pavement repair work in Topeka/Shawnee County. Work will take place daily, Monday through Saturday between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.; no work will take place on Sunday. *(Repair work on eastbound I-70 from Urish Road to Danbury lane was completed on Tuesday, June 2.)*

Interchange ramps along I-70 may be closed for short durations to complete repair work on the ramps. Advance message boards will alert traffic to all lane and ramp closures on I-70. Drivers may encounter minor delays and are encouraged to use alternate routes, if possible. There will be a posted 50 mph speed limit through the work zone when crews are working on the I-70 project.
