For Friday/Saturday, October 21-22, 2011 in Lawrence/Douglas County

K-10

Eastbound and westbound entrance/exit ramps at the Church Street interchange will be closed for mill and overlay work beginning at **6:00 p.m. on Friday, October 21 and will reopen to all traffic at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 22.** Only one set of the Church Street interchange ramps will be closed at a time. When one pair of the interchange ramps are finished and reopened, then the other set of ramps will close. NOTE: There will be no lane closures on K-10 during this time period.

Advance message boards will alert drivers to the ramp closures. No marked detours will be provided. Drivers should expect minor delays and must use alternate routes during the ramp closures.

Project work is scheduled to be completed for this week on Saturday, October 22.
