U.S. 24 & Goodyear Road Interchange

EXPECT DELAYS! WEEKEND DAY LANE CLOSURES: Eastbound and westbound U.S. 24 right lanes either side of the west end of the bridges over Goodyear Road will be CLOSED for utility work on beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 17. The lanes will reopen to unrestricted traffic once the work is completed that day. These lane closures are needed so Westar Energy crews can string new power lines across the highway.

There will be no lane width restriction but there will be a 45 mph posted speed limit through the project work zone. Drivers should expect minor delays and will be directed through the project work zone via signage and cones.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through the project work zone.
