For Monday/Tuesday, May 3-4, 2010 to Late Fall 2010 – Douglas County

## <u>US-24</u>

Eastbound and westbound traffic over the Mud Creek Bridge, located 2.32 miles east of the US-24/US-59 junction, will be directed across the bridge round the clock, 24/7, via traffic signals at either end of the bridge, weather permitting, beginning on **Tuesday, May 4 (after early morning rush hour)** for a bridge repair project.

During the day on **Monday, May 3,** traffic will be directed across the bridge via flaggers while crews overlay the bridge deck in preparation for Tuesday's traffic signal activation.

Traffic will be restricted to an 11-foot lane width during the duration of the project. Drivers should expect minor delays and are advised to use alternate routes, if possible. Project work is scheduled to be completed in late fall 2010.
