Two bridges to be repaired in Topeka on June 22

Bridge patching work will take place on two bridges in Topeka on Thursday, June 22, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation

From 9 a.m. to noon, the southbound U.S. 75 to eastbound I-70 bridge will be reduced to one lane. From noon to 3 p.m., the westbound I-470 to eastbound I-70 bridge will be reduced to one lane and have a width restriction of 10 feet. There will be no speed limit reduction on either bridge.

Motorists are asked to use extra caution in the work zone areas and use an alternate route if possible.
