I-70 westbound lane reduced for concrete repair

Kansas Department of Transportation crews will reduce a section of I-70 in Topeka on Monday, Aug. 3, through Friday, Aug. 7, weather permitting. The lane closure is needed to replace concrete panels, according to the KDOT.

The westbound driving lane of I-70 will be closed from mile markers 353 to 351 as crews replace a concrete panel. One lane will be closed and drivers will be directed by signs with flashing lights, an arrow board and cones.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
