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## **Asphalt surfacing on K-4 in Shawnee County to begin Oct. 14**

An asphalt surfacing and pavement patching project on K-4 in Shawnee County, to begin Wednesday, Oct. 14, weather permitting. Work will occur during daylight hours on K-4 from eastbound I-70 east, to a quarter of a mile north of the U.S. 40 junction. The project is expected to be completed by the end of November.

Traffic will be controlled using daily lane closures in the work zone and ramp closures when needed. Motorists should expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Bettis Asphalt & Construction Inc. of Topeka is the contractor on the almost \$1.8 million project.
