Anticipated work schedule is:


Monday, Mar. 9 – I-70 eastbound and westbound BNSF/Shunganunga Creek Bridge.

Tuesday and Wednesday, Mar. 10-11 – I-70 eastbound Polk Quincy Viaduct.

Thursday and Friday, Mar. 12-13 – I-70 westbound Polk Quincy Viaduct.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane using mobile lane closures, trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards.
