Bridge inspections to reduce lanes in Lawrence

Kansas Department of Transportation crews will be inspecting bridges Wednesday, June 24 and Thursday, June 25 on U.S. 40/U.S. 59 in Lawrence, weather permitting.

Wednesday, June 24, traffic will be reduced to one lane westbound on the U.S. 40 bridge going over the Kansas River (Vermont Street) from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Thursday, June 25, traffic will be reduced to one lane eastbound on U.S. 40 on the bridge over the Kansas River (Massachusetts Street) from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Motorists should expect slow moving traffic and delays in the area.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
