

Bridge inspections to reduce lanes on U.S. 24

Kansas Department of Transportation crews will be providing traffic control for a bridge inspection on U.S. 24 in Topeka. The bridge is located at approximately mile marker 367, over Northwest Goodyear Plant Road, Friday, June 26, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

The right lane on westbound U.S. 24 will be closed and as the inspection progresses, the right lane will open and the westbound left lane will be closed. After the inspection is complete in the westbound lanes, the eastbound right lane will be closed and as the inspection progresses, the eastbound left lane will be closed. Traffic will be controlled using message boards, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should expect slow moving traffic and delays in the area.
