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Bridge maintenance project on I-470 in Topeka to begin Oct. 30

A bridge maintenance project on the westbound I-470 to westbound I-70 ramp and bridge, in Topeka, is expected to begin Friday, Oct. 30, weather permitting.

Work will begin at 6 p.m. Friday, Oct. 30 and continue 24 hours a day, to approximately 6 p.m., Tuesday, Nov. 3. This project includes deck patching along the centerline of the line of the bridge to fill numerous potholes, with a polyester polymer concrete.

The ramp and bridge will be closed for the duration of the project and traffic will need to find an alternate route. A detour will not be posted.

PCI Roads, LLC of St. Michael, Minn. is the contractor on the \$132,000 project.
