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
Core sampling on bridges along I-70 in downtown Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation is conducting a core sampling project on several bridge decks along westbound and eastbound I-70 in downtown Topeka. Work will occur from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and is expected to be complete in 30 days, weather permitting.

Core drilling will occur on the Adams Street/BNSF/Shunganunga Creek Bridge, the Polk Quincy Viaduct, the Third Street Bridge and the Fourth Street Bridge.

There will be intermittent lane closures as needed and traffic will be controlled using arrow boards and traffic cones.
