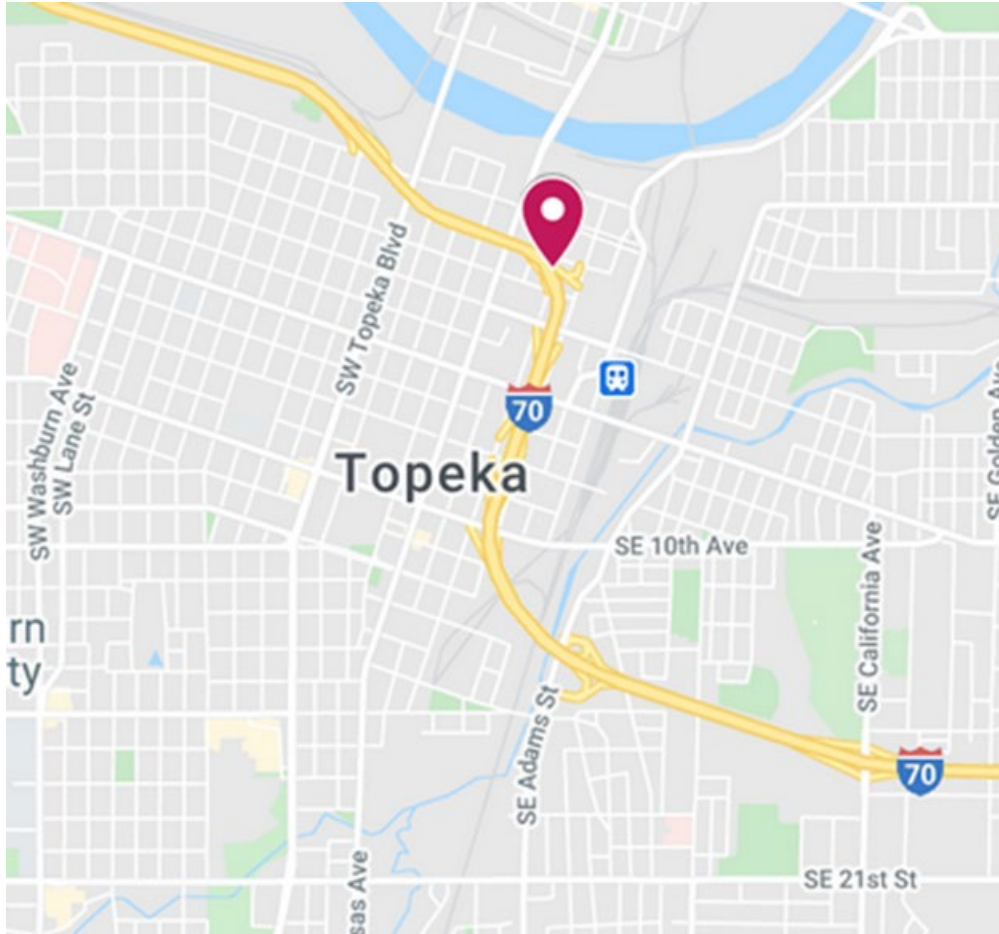

Patching on Polk Quincy Viaduct in Topeka continues

The Kansas Department of Transportation will continue concrete patching on westbound I-70 on the Polk Quincy Viaduct bridge in downtown Topeka the week of Oct. 5, weather permitting.

Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and is expected to be completed by Oct. 9. The right lane of westbound I-70 will be closed in the Polk Quincy Viaduct area, and traffic will be controlled using arrow boards, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should expect delays and be prepared to stop.
