Pothole patching on I-35 scheduled for July 13, 14

Intermittent lane closures will be taking place on I-35 from the 151st Street interchange south two miles to the truck weigh station on July 13 and 14, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

The lane closures are planned from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. both days and are necessary to allow KDOT crews to patch potholes along the highway.
