## Mill and overlay project on K-10 in Lawrence to begin today

A mill and overlay project on K-10 to begin Monday, August 3, weather permitting. This project is the second phase of the intersection improvement project at 27<sup>th</sup> Street/Wakarusa Avenue, expected to be completed in mid-October.


Work will occur beginning at the Farmer's Turnpike and going south to the U.S. 59/K-10 junction, 6 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday evenings to Saturday mornings.

Traffic will be controlled using a lane width reduction to 12 feet in the work area, speed limit signs, traffic cones and barricades. A pilot car operation will guide traffic during the night-time hours. Drivers should expect delays of about 15 minutes.

Also, as part of the intersection improvement project, 27<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed at 6 p.m., Wednesday, August 5 to 6 a.m., Thursday, August 6.

Hamm Inc, of Perry is the contractor on the \$4.3 million project.
