

Patching on Polk Quincy Viaduct in Topeka to begin Monday

The Kansas Department of Transportation will begin concrete patching on westbound I-70 at the Polk Quincy Viaduct bridge, in downtown Topeka, Monday, Sept. 28, weather permitting.

Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and is expected to be completed by Oct. 5. The right lane of westbound I-70 will be closed, from approximately mile marker 360 to 361, and traffic will be controlled using arrow boards, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should expect delays and be prepared to stop.
