Patching on U.S. 24 and NW Rochester Road to begin Sept. 3


The Kansas Department of Transportation will be patching potholes at U.S. 24 and Northwest Rochester Road, mile marker 369, in Topeka, on Thursday, Sept. 3 and Friday, Sept. 4, weather permitting.

Work will occur from 10:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. There will be intermittent lane closures. Westbound U.S. 24 right lane and the turning lane to Northwest Rochester Road will be closed each night.

Right hand turns from westbound U.S. 24 to NW Rochester Road will be prohibited during work hours. Westbound U.S. 24 traffic will be allowed in the left lane.

Traffic will be controlled using arrow boards, attenuator trucks and traffic cones. Drivers should expect delays and add extra travel time to their commute.
