Pothole patching at multiple locations in Topeka tomorrow

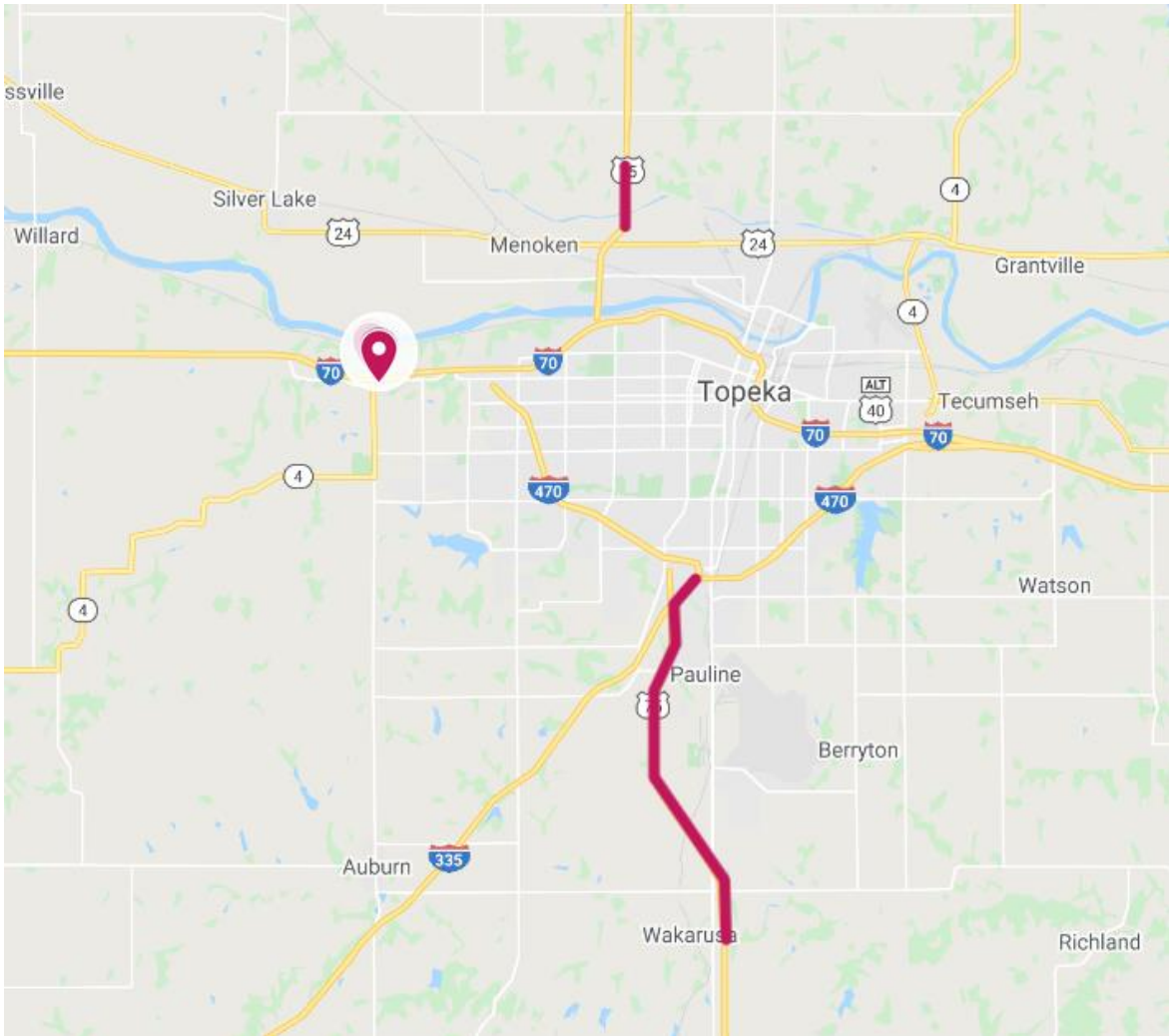
The Kansas Department of Transportation will be performing pothole patching at multiple locations in Topeka tomorrow, Feb. 4, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

Work will begin about 9 a.m. on the northbound and southbound lanes of U.S. 75 between mile markers 162-165. It is expected that the crews will move in the late morning to the northbound and southbound lanes of U.S. 75 between mile markers 144-153.

Another crew will begin pothole patching on the ramp at K-4 and westbound I-70 at 9 a.m. and are expected to move to work on the ramp from eastbound I-70 to K-4 in the afternoon.

Traffic will be controlled by mobile lane closures using trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
