

Pothole patching on Oakland Expressway ramps set for Sept. 2

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be patching potholes on the NE Seward Avenue exit and entrance ramps to and from the Oakland Expressway in Shawnee County on Wednesday, Sept. 2, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. weather permitting.

Motorists will be directed onto the shoulder as crews patch the potholes. Drivers should expect delays and add extra travel time to their commute.
